

# SHIPPING AND FULFILMENT

Shipping and Fulfilment is a crucial step in your e-commerce business but it can be daunting to jump right in. However as the last step in your products journey before reaching your customer it is an important step to understand. You have a lot of options to choose from with your new e-commerce website so lets take a look at the steps to get there.

#### **PACKAGING**

The first step is finding the right packaging for your product

#### SIZE

Your product should fit in the packaging comfortably without a lot of room to move around but should not be a tight aqueeze

#### **PROTECTION**

Finally remember the point of the packaging is to protect your product to make sure it arrives at the destination in the same condition it left. Consider if you need bubble wrap or should put a fragile label on your package.

#### **PRESENTATION**

You should also consider what the customer is going to see when they get your package. Plain or Custom boxing? Do you want to have an insert? Small details can go a long way to building brand loyalty.

There are quite a few carriers to choose from including **UPS**, **USPS**, **DHL**, and **FedEx**. Each one has pros and cons depending on your business. The good news is that all of them are easily integrated into your brand new website.

- IMPORT/EXPORT FEES WHEN SHIPPING INTERNATIONALLY


Don't forget to consider package insurance, tracking labels and how long it will take your package to reach its destination. Make sure you are able to set the right expectations and are not leaving your customers waiting for their packages for too long.



#### **INTEGRATION**



Your new website uses the WooCommerce integration into Wordpress to add your e-commerce capabilities. Once you have determined your shipping carrier making sure that you can fulfil orders right out the gate and print labels easily can all be added seamlessly using one of the available WooCommerce extensions. Simply choose the service you want and add the extension to your site. They have an existing relationship with USPS and DHL so you can add those for free! Other carriers may incur annual costs you should use in your calculations for your overall shipping costs.

#### **BONUS: PAYMENT PROCESSOR**













Make sure to choose a Payment Processor while you are at it.

- WooCommerce comes with built in PayPal functionality which you can be enabled and disabled with a click of a button.
  However, you must integrate your PayPal account with WooCommerce.
- The WooCommerce Payments extension securely accepts major credit and debit cards, and local payment methods on your site with no setup costs or monthly fees.\*
- Square, Stripe, and Amazon Pay also have integrations that are free to add if you already have an existing payment option or are just looking to add new additional ones.
